
Community Service Hours

The Greatest Need Luke 5:17-26

The Point: Only Jesus can take care of our need for forgiveness.

The Bible Meets Life: DIY, do it yourself. It saves you money, gives you a sense of pride and accomplishment, and is also a great learning opportunity. Sometimes it's a great idea and the best way to accomplish a task or complete a project.

There are other times when DIY just won't work. Certain jobs need a specific professional, and DIY won't cut it. If you have a tooth problem, you go to a dentist, not a cardiologist, even if he is a world-renowned heart doctor. And if you have a cardiac issue, you don't call a mechanic. Some friends in the passage we'll be studying had an issue that was not a DIY project. They wanted healing for a paralyzed friend. As much as they helped him, carried him, and maybe even tried to coach him to walk, it wasn't happening. In fact, what afflicted their friend was greater than what they could see. Their friend needed a special, one-of-a-kind professional.

His name was Jesus. Only Jesus had the cure for what ailed their friend, but seeing Jesus wouldn't be as easy as they thought.

Live It Out: Identify with the paralytic man. How do you relate to the paralytic man? What fears or sins paralyze you? Ask God to reveal these things to you. Then turn them over to Him and walk forward in faith. Identify with the religious leaders. In what ways are you like the religious leaders? How have your actions and attitudes prevented others from seeing who Jesus is? Ask God to reveal these things to you. Then turn them over to Him and walk forward in faith. Identify with the friends. In what ways do you resemble the friends? Identify someone in your community who needs help with a physical need and provide for them in Jesus's name.
