

Pastor David's Corner

Give Thanks

Giving thanks to the Lord is a central theme in the Bible, rooted in God's goodness, enduring love, and wonderful acts. This expression of gratitude is presented not as a mere suggestion but as a posture of worship and a foundation for the Christian life.

Foundational reasons for giving thanks

The scriptures offer several core reasons to give thanks to the Lord, grounded in His character and actions:

His goodness and unfailing love: A recurring theme throughout the Psalms is giving thanks because "the LORD is good; his love endures forever". His covenant love (Hebrew: *hesed*) is steadfast, reliable, and eternal.

His wonderful works: The psalmist often calls for praising God for His "wonderful deeds for mankind". These include His role in creation, His deliverance of His people from danger, and His provision in times of need.

His role as Creator: God is to be thanked for His wisdom in creating the heavens and the earth, and for sustaining His creation.

His mercy and redemption: Believers are called to give thanks for God's mercy and for the victory He gives through Jesus Christ.

O give thanks to the Lord, acknowledge His goodness and mercy in prayer, praise Him through song, and give thanks for both His great works and His daily provision in your life.

Acknowledge His goodness: Start by thanking God for who He is, as in "Thank you, Lord, for all that you have done for me".

List specific blessings: Mention specific things you are grateful for, such as good health, family, or your job.

Give thanks in all circumstances: The Bible encourages giving thanks in all situations, not just when things are going well.

Sing hymns and praise songs around your house, in the car, or during your quiet time to renew your mind and to remind yourself and others of God's truth.

1 Thessalonians 5:18: "give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus."





Bible Studies For Life Summary From Problems to Praise

Prayer is far more than asking God for things, but it's certainly not less



than that. There are many times in Scripture where God acts in response to the requests of His people. Though this subject is shrouded in mystery, the fact remains that God works through the prayers of believers. He has invited us to participate in His work in this world and one of the primary ways we do that is through prayer. We may not know exactly how this

works, but we have a clear picture of why God operates this way.

When God answers the prayers of His children, it provides an opportunity for Him to receive glory. This happens on a personal level when we give Him praise and on a much larger scale when we tell others about it. It would be a terrible display of ingratitude for us to receive an answer to prayer and forget to thank God or fail to proclaim His greatness. In this special focus session, Hezekiah received a life-altering answer to prayer and remembered to thank God and praise Him in the presence of others.


Lunch Bags for the Homeless
