### Sunday, November 10 2024

Joseph and His Brothers: Family Jealousy  
Genesis 37:1-4, 18-24, 31-34

**The Point:** Unchecked animosity can lead to greater harm within the family.

**The Bible Meets Life:** Jealousy thrives in the world of artists and musicians. One of the more renowned tales of jealousy comes from the classic movie *Amadeus*, which dramatizes the fictionalized account of Salieri's jealousy of Mozart. A couple of centuries after the musical reign of Mozart, composer Johannes Brahms remarked, "Those who enjoy their own emotionally bad health and who habitually fill their own minds with suspicion, jealousy, and hatred, as a rule take umbrage at those who refuse to do likewise, and they find a perverted relief in trying to denigrate them." But it's not just in the art world. Families often stew in that sort of emotionally bad health. The story of Joseph offers a clear example.

**Live It Out: Pray.** Pray for God to keep you from all forms of animosity and resentment. We must not tolerate attitudes of unkindness toward others. Left unchecked, the root of our wrong attitudes can grow into harmful actions with bitter consequences. **Share.** Contemplate what you can do to stop these types of issues from taking root in your heart. Connect with a friend who knows you well and share with that person your struggles. **Forgive.** With God's help, begin the process of forgiving someone from a past hurt. Start the process of reconciliation with that individual (Ephesians 4:31-32).
