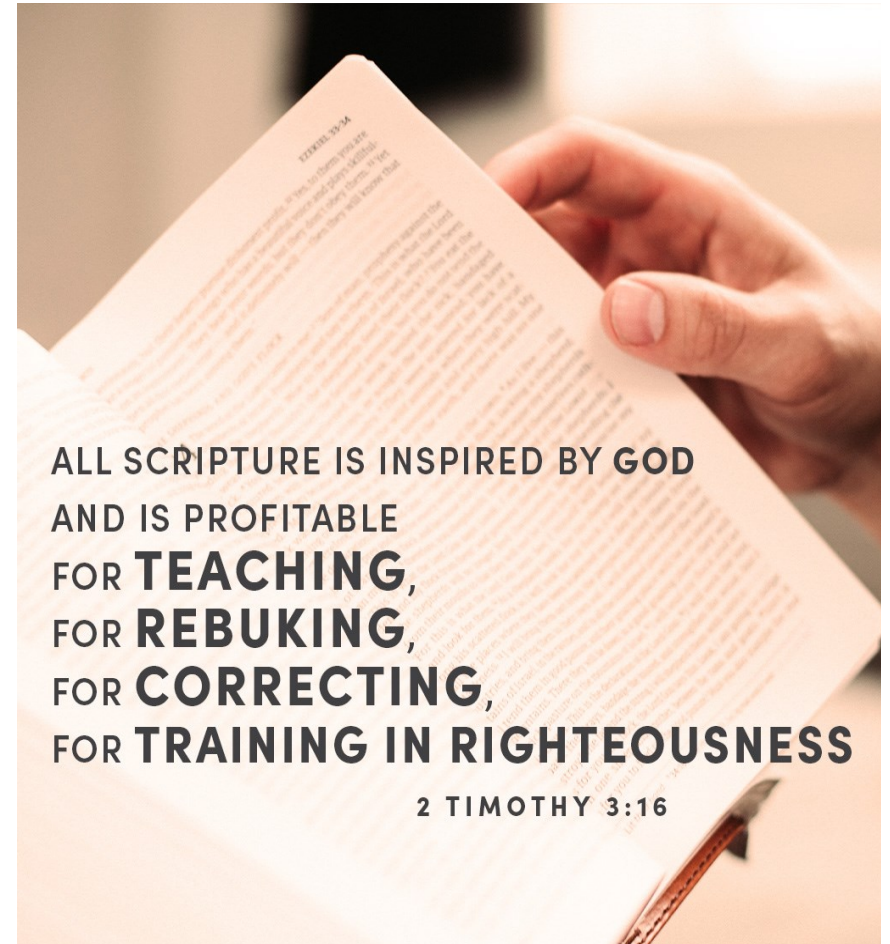

Why We Need God's Word (2 Timothy 3:1-5, 13-17)

The Point: The Bible reveals everything we need to live victoriously.

The Bible Meets Life: Have you ever been to the symphony? You grab a program, find your seat, and wait for the performance to begin. Gradually the individual musicians enter stage right. Moments later, a commotion sounds forth; but it's not the masterpiece you came to enjoy. Rather than a harmonious blend of musical artistry, you hear a cacophonous mess of instrumental anarchy, as individual musicians do their own thing to tune and warm up. Soon, however, the conductor steps up to the podium and taps his baton. At the wave of his hand, the concert begins, the orchestra plays, and the result is symphonic pleasure. The difference? All the players are playing their parts of the composer's score. Everyone is following the leadership of the conductor.

In this life, we live in spiritual anarchy. Most people do what's right in their own eyes, rather than looking to any authoritative source to guide their actions. As believers, we can easily be confused. However, when we ground our lives on God's Word, we follow the Conductor of the universe while playing His beautiful song.

Live It Out: Join the band. Perhaps you recognize you've never tuned your life to the song of Jesus. If you've never trusted Christ for forgiveness and salvation, do so now. Talk to a trusted leader or pastor to help you take the next steps. **Play the same song.** Maybe you're trying to march to the beat of two different drummers. If you've been walking in unrepentant sin, confess your sin to God. Make a plan to regularly read God's Word so that you will consistently hear Him and follow His call on your life. **Lead rehearsal.** You regularly take in God's Word and inherently know your need for it. Share what you've learned this week with someone else. Perhaps it's asking a friend to coffee or maybe it's leading a small group Bible study. Pass God's Word on to others.
