

Pastor David's Corner

Life, Liberty & the Pursuit of Jesus

2 Corinthians 3:17 says, "Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom; there is liberty." If we're looking for freedom, the Bible shows us where it may be found. Romans 6:22 states, "now that you have been set free from sin and have become slaves of God, the benefit you reap leads to holiness, and the result is eternal life." In pursuing this liberty from sin and self, we now become enslaved to God, which makes us holy, and leads to life! 1 Peter 2:16 punctuates the point, "Live as free people, but do not use your freedom as a cover-up for evil; live as God's slaves." Now that we are free, now that we have life, we must be transformed to a higher mission.

John says in 8:36, that if the Son of God sets you free, you are free indeed, and herein lies the key. Are we truly free? Will we ever, as an individual or as a people, be free apart from freedom in Christ? For Christians, we recognize that liberty, true and lasting, starts with God, through a relationship with His Son. But, our country is not a Christian nation, so many of our compatriots will disagree, and thus the foundational divide begins at the core.

In Matthew 5:6, we read, "Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be satisfied. Oh, that we may be satisfied in desiring God's will in our lives, in the lives of our family, friends, community and country! Romans 15:13 tells us, "Now may the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit." The answer is out there, but who will desire, seek, pursue and find it? We must know God, so that we will love God, so that we will follow God.

Freedom is not free. All gave some; some gave all. This is a popular patriotic saying. The Bible takes it a step further and states that One died for all, so that all might live. Yet, the Lord calls us to pick up our own cross daily and die to ourselves, so that we may spiritually see clearly enough to follow Christ. Life. Liberty. The Pursuit of Jesus. What does it take to obtain liberty? It appears that we may already know the answer. It's just that some have ears to hear, and some do not.




Bible Studies For Life Summary

Set Apart: A Life Lived for God

The greatest changes in history are happening right now, in our time.

The digital age has reconfigured our world. Things once thought unimaginable have come to pass, forever altering our lives. It's estimated that our world has undergone about 15 percent of the changes expected from the digital revolution. People everywhere feel stretched and sometimes torn by the never-ending changes we are enduring. Many are beleaguered as the digital age disorients and sometimes dehumanizes people.
