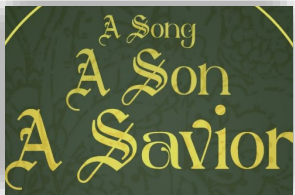
Christmas Cards

From Problems to Praise

Isaiah 38:9-20

The Point: Thank God and praise Him for how He answers prayer.

The Bible Meets Life: Death is not often a topic of conversation at the office party or the dinner table. In fact, we avoid the topic of death just about as much as we attempt to avoid death itself. But it hasn't always been this way. In earlier times, cemeteries were almost always located near a church—and not just any church. Those who were buried in a given cemetery were quite often active members of the church next door to their final resting place. Their descendants passed by the graveyard and the headstones of great grandma and grandpa every time they went to church. Death was a familiar topic and so it was not uncommon to contemplate one's own mortality.

Against the cultural trend of avoiding the topic, pop and country artists have urged their audiences to live like it's your last days of life. But why? Who wants to think about the brevity of life and the reality of death every day? What good could come from that? This is the lesson Hezekiah learned when he narrowly escaped the clutches of a fatal illness.

Live It Out: Pray Alone. Wherever you are in the discipline of prayer, take things up a notch. Set aside time every day for uninterrupted conversation with God. Present your desires and requests to him and watch for His response. **Pray Together.** Invite others to pray for you and with you. Most of the instructions in the New Testament are not only for the individual believer, but for the entire faith community. Prayer is a team sport; choose your teammates wisely. **Proclaim.** When God responds to your prayers, share it with other people, especially unbelievers. This will encourage believers to pray and unbelievers to consider the work of God in their own lives.
