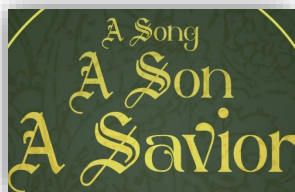

When Doing God's Work Is Interrupted

Acts 16:4-15

The Point: God may interrupt us to move our ministry in a new direction.

The Bible Meets Life: On May 21, 2020, twin brothers Zak and Max Prizant took their first step in a journey across America on foot. They started on San Francisco's Golden Gate Bridge, and along the way encountered wild stallions, temperatures in the triple and single digits, rattlesnakes, and 800 miles of oncoming traffic on I-80 West. They completed their 3,000-mile journey on New Year's Eve, finishing on the Brooklyn Bridge and raising \$15,000 for COVID relief.

Now, repeat that trek 2.5 more times. That's how far Paul and his companions traveled (over 10,000 miles) as missionaries. They faced many life-threatening hazards, and unlike the Prizants, they endured physical attacks and imprisonments to spread the gospel and start churches.

In all the experiences they had, something unusual happened during the second missionary journey. God halted their plans, rerouting their mission efforts. What do you do when the ministry God has blessed is cut short or brought to an end?

It's time for a road trip with Paul and lessons in listening to God.

Live It Out: Seek God's will. Set aside time this week to evaluate your spiritual life. Ask God to reveal His will to you in specific areas of your life. **Stay spiritually attuned.** In every situation you are in, pay attention to the possibility of a gospel opportunity. Take time to review some key Bible passages you might use to share the gospel. Always be consciously surrendered to the Spirit's leading and power (1 Cor. 2:3-4). **Tell others about Jesus.** Read Romans 10:14-15. Lydia heard the gospel from Paul and God opened her heart to believe. That's the pattern God uses. Who can you tell about Jesus this week?
