



God's Hand in Meeting Our Needs

2 Kings 4:1-7

The Point: God provides for our needs.

The Bible Meets Life: Floyd told our small group he had been sensing God was calling him into full-time Christian ministry. The next step would be going to a theological seminary for training. There was just one problem: Six months earlier he had made a commitment to his parents to take a lead role in the family business. Going to seminary would leave his parents in a bind. We asked what he planned to do. He said he had prayed about it and then said, "I just found out my older sister and her husband are moving back home to start working in the family business." I said, "Great! When do you start seminary?" He replied, "Well, I'm still not sure if God is calling me into ministry." Floyd had a real need in his life and God provided a solution, but he was having trouble seeing it. We need God's help, especially in times of uncertainty or distress. The question isn't, "Will God respond?" More often the question is, "Will we respond to God's help in faith and obedience?" Today's session will encourage us to do just that.

Live It Out: Assess the true needs in your life. Sometimes it may be difficult to distinguish between wants and needs in our lives. Ask God to reveal to you what are the true needs in your life. Ask for help. Lower your pride and raise your faith by asking God to help you in your time of need. Make it a matter of consistent prayer. Help those in need. Look for God's hand at work revealing to you how you can be a blessing by meeting the needs of someone who is in a desperate situation. Ask God to help you to be discerning, sensitive, and compassionate in response to those in need.
