

Pastor David's Corner

Temptation, Struggle and Sin

There's no getting around it, we all struggle with temptation and sin (Romans 3:23). Even Paul lamented over his ongoing struggle with sin: "For I know that nothing good dwells in me, that is, in my flesh. For I have the desire to do what is right, but not the ability to carry it out. For I do not do the good I want, but the evil I do not want is what I keep on doing. Now if I do what I do not want, it is no longer I who do it, but sin that dwells within me" (Romans 7:18-20). His struggle was real; so much so that he cried out, "What a wretched man I am! Who will rescue me from this body that is subject to death?" (Romans 7:24).

Yet in the next breath, he answers his own question, as well as ours: "Thanks be to God, who delivers me through Jesus Christ our Lord!" (Romans 7:25a). In this passage, Paul not only provides us with the very key to victory in struggling with sin, but explains the neverending challenge between our sinful nature and spiritual nature: "So then, I myself serve the law of God with my mind, but with my flesh I serve the law of sin" (Romans 7:25b).

As long as we live in this world, our sinful nature and fleshly desire will remain with us. But we also have a new nature in Christ. This leads to a struggle between what we want to do and what we actually do, as sin continues to assault our earthly nature. This battle is a normal part of living the Christian life. Ugh!

A true Christian will naturally periodically war with Satan and his daily efforts to undermine us. The devil is the ruler of this world, and we are living "behind enemy lines" (Ephesians 2:2; Ephesians 6:12; John 12:31). With our focus on Christ, however, we will be able to cultivate a mindset that proclaims we're willing to fight to not hurt our God. When we give ourselves to Christ totally (Matthew 16:24), Satan will flee from us. When we draw near to God, He, in turn, will draw near to us (James 4:7-8). These are powerful promises!

Our key then, to victory in our struggle with sin, lies in the very promise of God Himself: "No temptation has overtaken you that is not common to man. God is faithful, and He will not let you be tempted beyond your ability, but with the temptation He will also provide the way of escape, that you may be able to endure it" (1 Corinthians 10:13). This originates not in ourselves, but in God and His faithfulness to us: "The LORD is near to all who call on Him, to all who call on Him in truth" (Psalm 145:18; see also Psalm 46:1). Take courage!




Youth Rally

There are many things most of us wouldn't dream of doing. For example, I would never consider committing murder. That's just not a struggle for me! But a critical spirit? That's a struggle, and from my observation, many others battle with this as well.

One of the challenging aspects of carrying a critical heart is that we can feel justified in feeling that way.
