

# Pastor David's Corner

#### Easter, Communion & Baptism

Have you ever considered Easter and baptism as reminders? It's probably easier to recognize communion as such. In fact, we almost always share com-Pastor David's Corner munion at Easter time, as a reminder of what Christ did, and accomplished, on the cross. That, in and of itself, helps us to recollect the death and burial. Then, the music, message of the empty tomb, and celebration of/on Easter Sunday completes the triplet reminder of death, burial, and resurrection.

But have you ever considered baptism to also be a remembrance, for those of us believers attending the blessed event? I believe the Bible teaches that baptism is a unique and powerful reminder of the gospel, and our death, burial and resurrection. It's a sign of God's promises to us. It celebrates and reminds us of what God has done for us in Christ.

He has united us to Jesus (Matt 28:18-20), He has cleansed us of our sin (Acts 22:16), our old life is gone, and He has given us a new life (Rom 6:1-4), and has joined us in membership to His church (Acts 2:41). Jesus commands that everyone who follows Him should be baptized (Matt 28:18-20).

Because baptism symbolizes all these things that God has promised to us in Christ and His promises are never in doubt, we only need to be baptized once. But here's the thing, baptism is not a one-time reminder. Every baptism we witness serves us as a reminder of ours!

Like Easter, communion and baptism are not singular events but ongoing cues of the gospel in our lives. God says that we should practice them over and over again (Matt 28:19-20; 1 Cor 11:23-26). This doesn't mean that we should be baptized over and over again. Instead, we should participate in baptism over and over again by witnessing members of our church family get baptized. When we see this sacrament, we get the benefits of the reminder too!

Like reading the Bible, listening to a sermon, or praying, baptism and communion are channels of God's strengthening grace in our lives. When we see a baptism or take communion, the presence of Jesus is spiritually right there with us, giving us grace in real time! (1 Cor 10:16) Without the regular reminder that baptism brings, we can become forgetful and spiritually weak.

We don't just need to hear about God's love for us. We need to feel and experience it through the reminder of communion and baptism over and over again. Watching other people in our church family receive the covenant promises from God through baptism reminds us of the love God has for all his people. This Easter season, let us come together and be reminded of what He has done, in Easter Celebration & Worship, in communion, and the following Sunday, in baptism!




