

### Pastor David's Corner

#### The Reason for the Season

Around the holidays, you may come across the phrase "Jesus is the reason for the season" on the radio, stamped on the back of a pick-up truck, or while standing in line for that last-minute gift! So, what does it mean exactly? While Christmas is a cultural holiday, it is also a religious holiday when the family of faith celebrates the birth of God's Son, Jesus Christ. In the hustle and bustle of Christmas, it can be quite easy for us to ignore the "why" behind the holiday. So, we recite the catchy quote "Jesus is the reason for the season" to remind ourselves the true meaning of Christmas – the salvation born of our Savior's birth.

"Jesus is the reason for the season" is also a reminder of what Christmas is not about. While Christmas gives us many things to enjoy, like parties, carols, and decorations, it's important to remember that the true and lasting joy of the season comes from the hope of Jesus. Our treasured Christmas traditions, such as exchanging presents, counting down with an advent calendar, and sharing a meal with loved ones, all beautifully remind us of the gift of Jesus Christ.

While we do not know the exact date of Jesus' birth, as believers we choose to celebrate the life of Christ at the December 25th Christmastime. The date itself is not important. God's Word in Luke 2:11 says, "For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord." That is what's important! Jesus, the Son of God, came to earth thousands of years ago, and was called Immanuel, which means "God With Us." He was miraculously born to a virgin named Mary. We celebrate this.

He came to earth to bring hope to the world. He lived a perfect life on our behalf, laid down His life for us, and defeated sin and death by rising from the grave. Today, Jesus Christ is very much alive, seated beside God in heaven. He offers forgiveness and eternal life to all those who trust in Him. Acts 4:12 says, "Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to mankind by which we must be saved." That is a strong reason to rejoice!

Just like a Christmas present, Jesus offers salvation as a gift; there is nothing we can do to earn it (Ephesians 2:8). How amazing that God loved us so much that He would send His only Son to earth to die in our place so that we can intimately know our Creator and live with Him forever. This is the season, and He is the reason!





Friend, I wish I could help! But I have no time. I have no money. I have no plan. I'm just exhausted. My tank's empty. I don't think I'm your person. I'm not sure that's inside the parameters of our company policy. My calendar is slammed. I'm all out of those. I can't find what you need.



This chorus of universally common responses sounds familiar. We've heard them. We've said them. And sometimes they really are true. We live high-capacity lives, with low-capacity funds and dwindling time. Everywhere we turn we find overextended, underfunded people with limited margins, few guardrails, and contracted capabilities. Our culture thrives on scarcity of time, money, and ability. But when confronted with the needs of a lost and weary world, you'll never find those excuses in the pages of your Bible.

Jesus is truly an all-sufficient Savior who supplies everything we need. And He longs to show us how to escape the bounds of scarcity. We can learn His way and discover that little really does become much.
