

Pastor David's Corner

Madly in Love

Have you ever been, that? Was there a time in your life where you experienced the quintessential feelings, emotions, and season of being head-over-heels, crazy in love? I hope that you have and actually pray that you are still engulfed in it, for it is truly wonderful. Can I share a secret?

I am madly in love, with my job! And this is no casual fling, people. It's been many years and I grow deeper in love with this great calling upon my life every passing moment. Why, might you ask, would someone have such a love affair with their work? Is it not supposed to be toil and trouble?

For me, it's the magic of three! People love their work when three important aspects come together: doing work they're really good at, when they feel valued by their team (I like to say work family), and they feel appreciated by the ones who receive the ministry (as the extended family is benefitted in a tangible way).

In a series of studies, it has been shown that "how" people spend their time (vs. money) has a dramatic impact on the joy they feel. If money does not make you happy, and it won't, consider time. Spend time with the right people. Spend time doing the right work. Be aware that joy and fulfillment change over time. Even certain ministries and mission work changes in our effectiveness, so a shift may be in order.

What is God calling you to do and where? Is someone else micromanaging your day, or are you in a place of freedom to choose the path in life and work that God has set aside for you? Do you have a sense of purpose, a well -intentioned goal, of being part of something meaningful? Are you integral to a well-defined mission? Are you being effective, making a concrete difference in the world? These factors resonate deeply with why I love my job, my church, my role, my position.

It's important to work with people who bring out the best fruit in you—people who make you better and who you make better. Together, you amplify each other. That's the magic and beauty of teams, families, ministries, and missions that are fruitful, that enable us to achieve so much more as a group than we can do on our own.

Research has proven that if you write down things you're grateful for—I try to write down my top five at the end of each week—you'll cultivate that gratitude and joy so vital in keeping the momentum going forward. Include your work, your mission, your ministry in your love letter each week! Let it be OK that you love your job. Work can be so extraordinary. People don't always understand that—some people may look at me strangely when I talk about how much I love my job, my church, my flock, my family. But I can't help it. I'm madly in love!


Grief Share Group


