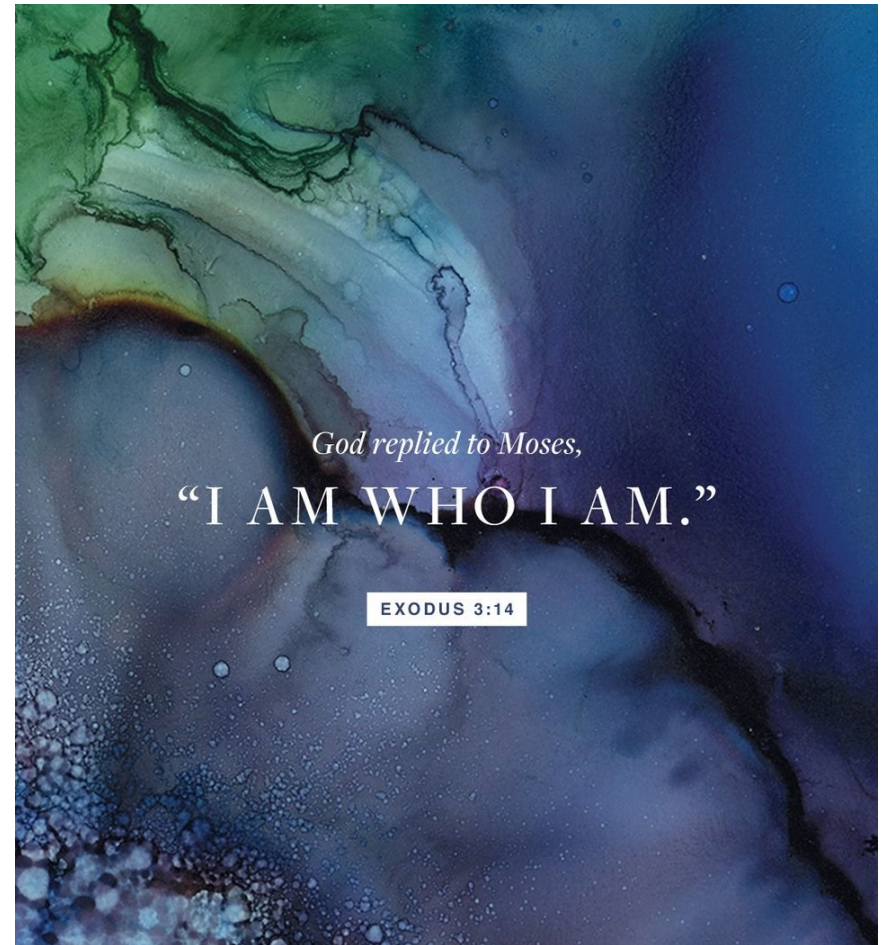

God Speaks to His People

Exodus 3:1-5, 11-15; 4:28-31

In Focus: God loves us enough to speak to us.

Look at out World: All kinds of things happen in our world—some we attribute to nature, others we call “acts of God.” How we interpret things depends on the lens we use. One of the most consistent physical realities we encounter is gravity. It’s universal, predictable, and unchangeable. Drop a ball, and it falls—every time. We don’t argue with gravity or try to ignore it. We adjust our lives to it.

Just as we must acknowledge and respond to physical realities like gravity, we must also recognize that spiritual realities are even more foundational. And one of the most essential spiritual realities is this: God speaks.

The Bible is filled with examples of God speaking—sometimes in thunder, sometimes in a whisper—but always with clarity and purpose. When God speaks, it’s not just to inform us; it’s to invite us into His work. And just like gravity, His voice demands a response. Many people miss this because they interpret life only through what they can see or touch.

We need a shift in our perspective—to move from a purely physical understanding of the world to a spiritual one. When we align our view with God’s truth, we see His voice is not distant or rare—it’s present, active, and personal.

Live It Out: View of God. Reflect on a time when you sensed God speaking. What did that moment reveal about His character, His purposes, or His presence? Write down what you learned about who God is. **View of self.** Trace a sequence of choices you made in response to God. How did your choices shape you? What do they reveal about how you see yourself? **View of others.** Meet with a friend willing to share how God worked in his or her life. Consider: What does his or her story reveal about how God works?
