

When Your Circumstances Fall Short 2 Corinthians 1:8-10; 12:6-10

The Point: God's grace will sustain you through anything.

The Bible Meets Life: The people of Waverly, Tennessee, knew it would be a rainy Saturday, but who could have imagined seventeen inches of rain in just twenty-four hours? The flooding came quickly. Scott Brown, pastor of First Baptist Church Waverly was preparing for his daughter's birthday party, but before he knew it, he found himself thrust into the center of a historic flood that would take the lives of twenty people. What could have been a relaxing day celebrating a birthday became a chaotic day of difficult phone calls, food lines, counseling, and make-shift shelters.

Life can turn on a dime. Although we may not have experienced severe flash floods like Waverly, we've all experienced life's sudden shifts. The apostle Paul experienced too many to count, but he understood that God's grace can sustain us through our hardest days and darkest nights.
