

Sharing Christ

Matthew 28:18-20; 2 Corinthians 5:16-21

The Point: We are to invite others into a relationship with Christ.

The Bible Meets Life: I remember when I first heard about COVID-19 and thought it was an isolated problem in a distant part of the world. On December 31, 2019, China reported 27 cases of "viral pneumonia," which was later identified as a new type of coronavirus named COVID-19. Soon it spread to Thailand, then Japan, then South Korea. By January 24, 2020, the virus had reached Europe. It spread until it touched the entire world. By December 2022, authorities in 227 countries and territories had reported cases.

Now, nearly everyone you talk to has either had COVID or knows someone who has. The scope and speed of the viral spread was unprecedented. Why? At least one person in China traveled outside the country, taking the highly contagious virus. Time and again, as people moved throughout the world, they took the virus with them.

While the pandemic was a rapid spread of the worst possible kind, it provides an illustration of God's plan for the gospel. One person shares it with another, who shares with another, who shares with another. Today's passages remind us that the authentic church is a church that shares the good news.

Live It Out: Study. Read a book on how to share your faith. Implement one suggestion from the book. Share. Write your testimony (before I met Jesus; how I met Jesus; since I met Jesus). Share it with someone you have never told. Support. Volunteer to mentor a new Christian. Meet with that person regularly to pray, study the Bible, and answer questions.
