God is Eternal

Psalm 102:18-28

The Point: Those who trust in the eternal God will live with Him forever.

The Bible Meets Life: Humans can't really grasp something lasting forever. For us, a dynasty is three Super Bowls in a row. That's a far cry from the phrase, "World without end, Amen," found in Ephesians 3:21 (KJV). For us to think about an eternal God requires a rewiring of our brains—a capacity to imagine a God who can look at the surface of a DVD and see the entire story of humanity, rather than the three inches of videotape that we can see at any given time.

Yet, the book of Ecclesiastes says that God has "put eternity in [our] hearts" (Eccl. 3:11). That means that on some level the Lord has given us the capacity to grasp the infinite.

During this unit, we've talked about God's character. His holiness. His justice. His omnipotence. His love. But what if, after every one of these, you attached a temporal modifier:

God is holy...*for now*.

He's all powerful...*for now*.

He loves you...*for now*.

That would negate God even being God! The eternality of God is what grounds every other attribute of God. These aren't just temporary promises. They are for all time.

Live It Out: Reflect. Reflect on your relationship with God. Take time to pray and express your concerns. Remember that He is eternal and cares about your struggles. Trusting Him means knowing you're never alone. **Share.** Share your faith stories with friends or family. Talk about how you've experienced God's presence in difficult times. Encouraging others to trust in God can inspire them to seek a relationship with Him.
