The church office will be closed on Thursday (28th) & Friday (29th).



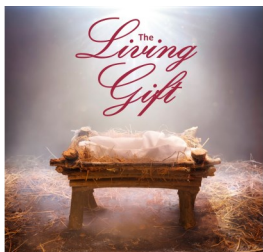
### Christmas Cards

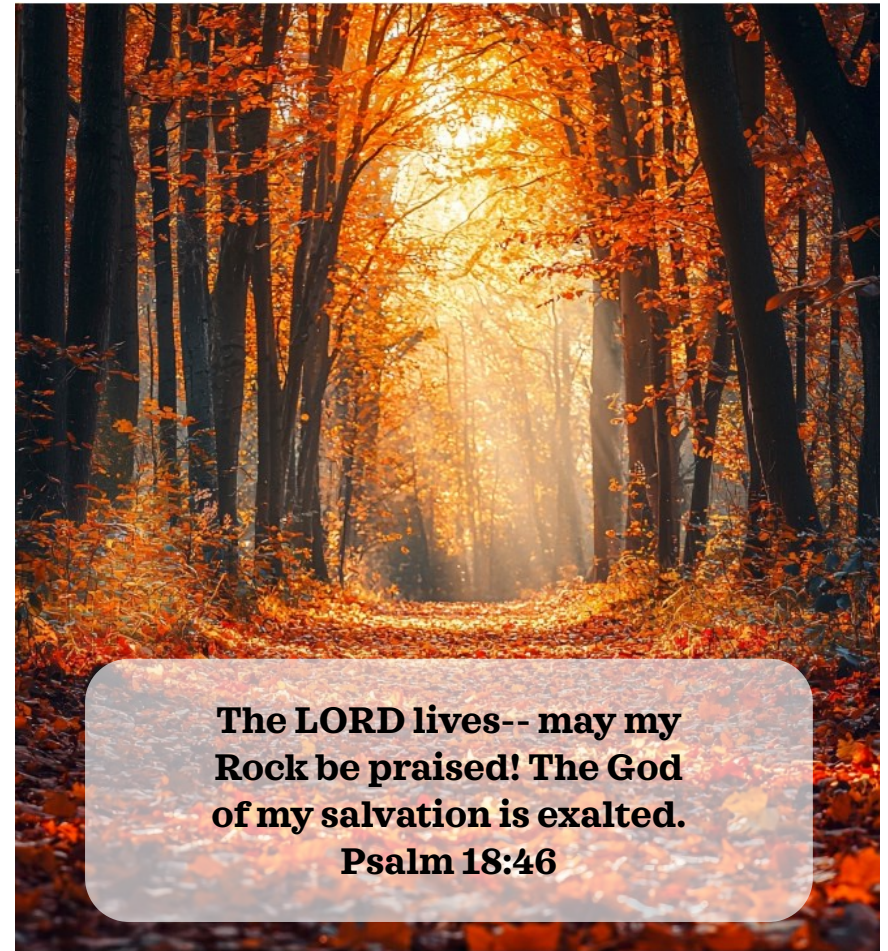

## Sunday, November 24 2024

The God Who Rescues

Psalm 30:1-12

**The Point:** We can be thankful that God rescues us.

**The Bible Meets Life:** The first Thanksgiving celebrated rescue. When the Pilgrims gathered in the fall of 1621, only half of the 102 Englishmen who had arrived on the Mayflower remained alive. All but three married couples had a spouse die during the first winter. Out of deep gratitude to be alive, the survivors paused to thank God. Our stories may be less dramatic, but they're no less testimonies of rescue. Maybe you cried for rescue when you came to the stark realization that math now included letters as you started algebra. You may have needed help with your children and grandchildren. Some of us have purchased a new phone but needed the help of someone more advanced in technology—and thankfully a seven-year-old came to our rescue!

David needed rescue and he cried out to God for help. We learn about the character of God in that He heard David's cry and came to his aid. In this study, we'll learn about the character of David in that he acknowledged his need to be rescued and cried out to God to meet his needs.

**Live It Out: Pray with a thankful heart.** Write down five things from which God has rescued you. Over the next five days, focus on one of those each day. **Write a thank you note.** Choose one of the times in your life in which God rescued you. Write a thank you note to the Father, expressing your gratitude for His care in stepping in to help you. **Share your story with someone else.** Choose someone close to you and share your story of God's rescue. Pray that God would use your story to encourage someone else in his or her journey with Him.
