Doing Life Together in Christ 1 Thessalonians 5:4-15

The Point: Believers share and experience life in Christ together.

The Bible Meets Life: The Jungle Book characters—Mowgli, Bagheera, Baloo, Kaa, and King Louie—have long entertained us. Mowgli, the boy raised by wolves in the Indian jungle, delights children and adults with his hilarious jungle adventures and animal friends. But the story of Dina Sanichar who inspired the book, was far from idyllic.

As a young child, Dina lived among wolves in the jungles of India, isolated from human contact. In 1867, hunters found six-year-old Dina and took him to a Sikandra mission orphanage. Initially, Dina continued to howl like a wolf and walk on all fours. He would only eat raw meat and chewed bones. Dina never learned human language or fully adapted to life among people. He died at thirty-five years old.

Experts say human interaction is essential for our mental and physical well-being. Loneliness and social isolation contribute to sleeplessness, reduced immune function, anxiety, depression, heart disease, stroke, and dementia. We need other people.

Nowhere is this truer than in the Christian life. Following Jesus is hard. We were never meant to do it in isolation. Believers were meant to do life together.


Live It Out: Find fellowship. Regularly invite someone at church you don't know well to dinner. Get to know this person more deeply. Support your leader. Pray for your pastor every week. Call or send a note stating your support and appreciation for him this week. **Invite** accountability. Ask a strong Christian of the same gender to be your accountability partner.
