Bring your filled shoeboxes back by Sunday, November 20th.






UBA OCC Collection

Obey God's Word (James 1:19-27)

<u>The Point</u>: We display the truth and value of God's Word as we live it out.

<u>The Bible Meets Life</u>: Experts—people who know what they're talking about—regularly offer sound advice that we regularly ignore.

- ▶ Mechanics recommend that we change the oil in our cars every so many thousand miles, but we often drive far beyond that before we get around to changing it.
- ▶ Doctors tell us to eat well and exercise regularly to foster good health, but most of us probably disregard this prescription at least some of the time.
- ▶ Dentists ask us to brush and floss our teeth routinely, but few of us look forward to giving him a report of our negligence at the next appointment.

The reality is, we know a lot of "best practices," but we do few of them consistently. Knowledge by itself is not enough; we must act on what we know. This principle applies to much more than oil changes, exercise regimens, and flossing habits. It also underscores the teaching of Scripture. We don't read, study, or memorize God's Word just to know it. God expects us to act on and obey what we learn.

Live It Out: Confess. Is there a sin in your life that God's Word is revealing to you? Allow God to wipe it off. Confess that sin to God. Receive His forgiveness and choose to walk in obedience. Commit. Is there a specific command or task God's Word is calling you to do, but which you have been procrastinating on doing? Commit to follow through and carry out that task. Pursue obedience. Counsel. You may know someone who is ignoring or struggling with obedience to God's Word. Encourage that person, pray for him, and walk with him to help him pursue a life of obedience.
