David: A Faith That Meets Adversity Head-on 1 Samuel 17:3-8, 32-37, 45-47

The Point: Faith moves with confidence in God.

<u>The Bible Meets Life</u>: Your eyes open wide as you leave the panic-filled recurring dream and awaken with rapid heartbeats and labored breathing. You immediately begin to worry about the unknown challenges of your new day. While hurrying to leave the house, you remember to do the countless things that help your family have an easier day. You jump in the car, hoping to catch green lights because you don't want to be late again.

As you wait at the second red light, you remember you forgot to pray. This is the third consecutive day. You're embarrassed and promised God you'll do better tomorrow. As you approach the fifth red light, your cellphone rings. You look down with great dread. The nurse wants you to schedule a consultation with a surgeon. After you disconnect, you say to God, "I can't do this again."

No one knows what a day will bring, but we're certainly better off facing challenges when we've spent time with God beforehand. We're told in Scripture that David was a man after God's own heart. That heart for God was developed in the grazing fields of his father's flocks. It was soon to be challenged by its greatest adversary yet.

<u>Live It Out</u>: Remember. Think back to the times in your life when you faced adversity and hardships. Did your response reveal weak or strong faith? Did your actions reflect God's Word? Trust God to keep His word as you pray and ask God for greater faith in adversity. Review. How did God respond when you showed strong faith? Remember how wonderful it felt for God to act on behalf of your faith? Don't hesitate to continue to trust God as your faith grows. Relationship. Your relationship with God will mature along with your faith. Teach others to strengthen their relationship with God through Scripture, prayer, and personal experience. Spend time mentoring someone who is working on his or her faith journey.
