A Way to Serve

1 Corinthians 12:12-24

The Point: God has empowered and equipped us to serve His church.

The Bible Meets Life: We like the image of the rugged individual. The guy who stands on his own two feet. The woman who grew a successful business by working hard. It's what made America great, right?

America is the land of opportunity, and we love the stories of those who found the opportunities and blazed their own trails: the Daniel Boones, George Washington Carvers, and Amelia Earharts.

Herbert Hoover coined the term "the rugged individual." In a 1928 presidential campaign speech, Hoover acknowledged that, because of World War I, the government had enlarged greatly. He had even approved it. But now, the war had long been over, and the government needed to ease off. Hoover and Americans should embrace the notion of rugged individualism and take care of themselves.

Rugged individualism might work in politics—but it fails miserably in the Christian life. As followers of Christ, we're not called to go it alone. In 1 Corinthians 12, Paul paints a picture of the church as one body—the body of Christ. As a body, God equips us to help and support one another.

Live It Out: Discover. If you're not sure where you can best serve in the church, ask for feedback from others. Friends can often see your gifts and abilities before you do. A spiritual gifts inventory can help you affirm how God has equipped you. **Serve.** If you see a need, step in and serve. Depending on the need and situation, you don't always need an invitation. That "tug on your heart" to step in could be the Holy Spirit's way of nudging you to use the gifts He has given you.
