

Choir Rehearsal


The next choir rehearsal to prepare will be Wednesday, April 10th at 7:45 PM.




Bible Studies For Life Summary Being an Authentic Church

The headline read: "Report: 500 Ukrainian Church and Religious Sites Damaged by Russian Military." The article began, "The Russian military has disproportionately attacked evangelical Christians and 'destroyed, damaged, or looted' at least 494 religious buildings, theological institutions, and sacred sites in Ukraine since invading the neighboring nation almost a year ago...."

Russian forces destroyed hundreds of churches, as have many empires through the ages, but they did not destroy the church. The church is sometimes called a building but not just a building. The church is also a charitable organization but not just a charity. It's more than a social group, voting block, or institution. It's the living, growing body of Christ comprised of all who follow Jesus Christ as Lord.

"Congregations across America are weak because many of us church

members have lost the biblical understanding of



what it means to be a part of the body of Christ.... He [God] placed us in churches to serve, to care for others, to pray for leaders, to learn, to teach, to give, and, in come cases, to die for the sake of the gospel." In this study, we will rediscover what it means to be an authentic church and how you play a role.
